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During the second half of the 19th century, Counts Vistarino and Gancia decided to plant French clones of pinot nero, having chosen the Scuropasso valley as ideal for the production of Metodo Classico spumante. The work of these great Piedmontese houses carried on. Today the firm, with the force of a great family estate (828 hectares, of which 200 are vineyard), and under the leadership of the young Ottavia, aims decidedly high to prove its definitive place.

Ries '13

Peach and bay leaf, pleasant aromas of white flowers. The palate is supported by a fresh acidic vein and intense minerality. A long and multifaceted finish.

Ries '14

Delicate bouquet of white flowers, citrus fruit and ginger. Herbaceous tones are sustained by a good acidic backbone and a savory finish. It lacks the energy to age for decades, but is already very focused.
