Pinot Noir Rosé Brut Sparkling Wine

Characteristics

Pale pink colour. Fine and persistent perlage, nose featuring hints of raspberry, wild strawberry and yellow fruit. Soft, enveloping taste with a well-balanced freshness.

Vineyards

Exposure: medium hilly area, West – South West exposure

Soil: Calcareous clay

Cultivation: Guyot

Plant density: 5500 plants/hectare

Harvesting

Collection method: Manual

Harvest period: last ten days of August

Yield per hectare: 90 Q/Hectare

Winemaking

The grapes, after maceration in the press for a few hours, undergo a soft pressing and the grape must (yield of 65%) is fermented in steel tanks. The base wine rests on the fine lees until December and is then converted into sparkling wine in an autoclave (Charmat method). After the second fermentation, the wine is aged for 6 months on yeast lees and bottled with a residual sugar of 8 g/L.

Total Acidity: 6,50 grams/liter

Volatile Acidity: 0,30 grams/liter

Contains sulfites
